- If wants to come in the room- (यदि कमरे के अन्दर आना चाहे)  
MAY I ENTER THE ROOM/CLASS.
- When the work is done- (जब कार्य खत्म हो)  
I HAVE DONE OR I HAVE FINISHED OR I HAVE COMPLETED MY WORK.
- When wants to have something from anyone- (जब कुछ लेना चाहे)  
PLEASE GIVE THIS TO ME.

KINDLY MAKE THEM LEARN ALL THE ABOVE LINES THOROUGHLY.

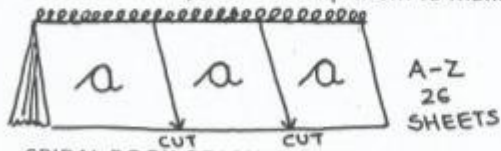
